



POLICIES

The following policies are created by Skyline Baptist church to ensure the safety and security of all children and give parent and child a positive experience.

A Child should not be brought into the Nursery/Toddler room when any of the following exist:

1. Fever within the last 24 hours
2. Vomiting or diarrhea
3. Any symptom of unusual childhood diseases: mumps, chicken pox, etc.
4. Bacterial infection
5. Croup
6. Any unexplained rash
7. Skin infection: boils, ringworm, impetigo
8. Pink eye or other eye infections
9. Yellow or green discharge from the nose

Additional Important Policies


-Please refrain from checking on your child as this will usually upset them. We will give you a pager and let you know if there is a problem

Registration & Check in/Check out

Family Registration Form

Each family needs to complete a family registration form that contains important contact information as well as information about each child. Once this is complete, the child's name will be added to the check-in list. Forms are available at the Nursery and Toddler rooms.

Child Name Tag Sticker

Each week a name tag sticker (see above) will be put on your child. There is a sticker for a diaper bag as well. The parent/guardian will be given the back of the sticker which a number on it corresponding to the number on your child's name tag sticker. Please present this when you return to pick up your child.

What to Bring

These are not required, but many parents find it helpful to bring a prepared bottle or juice, diaper bag (disposable diapers only), a change of clothing, or other personal items (please label).

3 Ways to Volunteer

Nursery & Toddler Rotation

It takes at least 8 people each Sunday to staff the nursery and toddler rooms. There is a monthly schedule for volunteers to serve during one service for one or two Sunday's a month.

Substitute

If you are unable to commit to a monthly obligation, consider being a substitute. Your name will be added to a list of people to call when someone is sick or going to be out of town.

Behind the scenes

There are a lot of little things that are necessary for this ministry to function well. Volunteers are needed to do laundry, clean and sterilize toys and nursery equipment, and organize and stock supplies.
