Watch out or you might be encouraged too!! Volunteers can choose to serve full-time or rotate one to three times a month. Every hand helps! Awana takes place Wednesday nights from 6:30 to 8, September through early May with summers off.

- Cubbies helper** Cubbie helpers stay with the Cubbies group from 6:30 to 8
- Volunteering at special events such as Grad Prix, Store Night, etc.**
- Craft Club** The craft club meets once or twice a month on Tuesdays at 10am to prepare crafts, décor, costumes, and more for Cubbies, Sunday School, VBS, Summer Camp, Good News Club, and the Christmas Program. Loy has a craft club schedule if you are interested.
- Providing and preparing Cubbies snacks**
- Childcare for volunteers' babies/toddlers** Childcare takes place from 6:15 to 8:15. See Loy for more details and find out how teen childcare helpers can earn funds for Skyline youth group events.
